

You can use your Student ID Card to log into the printer.






PRICES



Full Bedroom

€ 2,200 for Spring Semester 4.5 months.



Double Bedrooms € 1,500 for Spring Semester 4.5 months.



Triple Bedrooms € 1,100 for Spring Semester 4.5 months.



Full Apartment € 850 per month.

DURATION

Spring housing is until the 12th of May 2021.

LOCATION

AUM Apartments are located in Kalkara, St. Joseph Building.

20 min walk to campus or a short bus ride away on bus number 3.

DEPOSIT

Refundable security deposit of 500 Euro/St



AMENITIES

We strive to provide high quality, safe and comfortable accommodation at an affordable price.

All students will live with other AUM students in the apartment and will share a kitchen, bathroom, and common room.

Accommodation includes Internet access plus one free 10 euro electricity card each month, and a free cleaning service.



HOUSING NOTES

If students chose AUM Accommodation as part of their VISA application then they are required to LIVE ON CAMPUS FOR THEIR FIRST SEMESTER/INTAKE. After that they are welcome to move off campus if desired but must inform Identity Malta of their change in address if relevant.

Students are responsible for the cleaning of their own rooms but AUM provide a professional cleaning service monthly at no charge to students for common areas.

Co-Habitation (male/female) Rooms are not available (only in the case of married couples)

Flat mate/Roommate requests are possible, but you must email David O' Shaughnessy Manager of Student Affairs immediately upon receiving your visa and confirming your arrival at AUM. We can not guarantee that you will be able to live with a requested roommate, as accommodation is on a first come, first served basis.



HOUSING RULES

Residents are:

Not to commit or allow visiting guests to commit any form of harassment on the grounds of race, color, religion, sex, sexual orientation, age or disability which may interfere with the peace and comfort of, or cause offence to other guests, visitors, staff or neighbors.

Not to play or allow to be played any music or other devices so loudly that it causes a nuisance or annoyance to other guests or can be heard outside the building. Maltese law does not allow loud music in a residential area after 11pm.

Not to keep, or allow to be kept, or to consume any illegal drugs in the building. Smoking is not permitted within the apartments.

To maintain the premises in a clean and tidy state and to pay all costs incurred by the residence in making good any damage to the premises or to the residence fixtures, fittings and furnishings or to the common parts caused by the student or any invited visitor to the premises, fair wear and tear excepted.



HOUSING RULES

Residents are:

To report to the residence promptly any disrepair or defect for which the residence is responsible in the structure or exterior of the premises or in any installation therein or in the common parts.

To comply with the house rules as listed in this contract as well as other rules that could be introduced from time to time. These rules exist in order to allow good management of the residence.

Misplaced or lost keys, a new set can only be obtained at a cost.

To remove all personal possessions, to leave the premises and residence's fixtures and fittings in good condition and return the keys the day the contract expires. The residence accepts no responsibility for anything left on the premises by the resident at the end of the contract and may charge for the cost of disposal of any items left behind.



ENERGY POLICY

Electrical meters are installed at each AUM apartment.

Residents can purchase electrical cards from the Finance Department as and when needed.



CLEANING POLICY

All residents share the responsibility for keeping their apartments clean & tidy.

Cleaners will come monthly to clean communal areas of the flats and common area of the building.




