



Health Screening Procedure

Why do I have to do a health screening for my Temporary Residence Permit (TRP)?

All international students enrolled in Malta for over 3 months must undergo Health Screening, conducted at a **Private Clinic**. For students not pursuing nursing or any healthcare profession, Health Screening is **mandatory**, requiring the completion of the [Health Screening Form](#) for Students.

Who must do a Health Screening?

Students from **low-risk TB** countries need to only complete **Section 2: Vaccines and Blood Investigations**.

Students from **high-risk/very high-risk TB** countries must complete both **Section 1: Chest X-Ray** and **Section 2: Vaccines and Blood Investigations**.
